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(A) INTRODUCTION OF QUALITY BUILDING AWARD

The Quality Building Award is a biennial award giving public recognition to buildings of outstanding quality that demonstrate outstanding teamwork. The provision of quality buildings is an essential ingredient of a prosperous and modern society and the Quality Building Award aims to promote a collective commitment by the building industry to maintain the highest standards of professionalism and competitiveness.

The Quality Building Award 2006 carries a special theme – "Recognition of concerted effort by all building professionals to enhance building quality for the betterment of Hong Kong".

The Quality Building Award 2006 is jointly organized by nine leading professional organizations-

(B) AWARDS CATEGORY

Quality Building Awards will be presented to winners of each category listed below:

1) Residential Category

Submission Requirements

- Nominated buildings should be practically completed in the period between 1 January 2003 and 30 June 2005.
- The sole purpose of the nominated buildings should be for residential use.

2) Non-Residential Category

Submission Requirements

- Nominated buildings should be practically completed in the period between 1 January 2003 and 30 June 2005.
- The sole purpose of the nominated buildings should be for non-residential use.



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3) Sustainable Building Category

This is a new category pioneered by QBA2006. Under this category, special awards will be given to the following types of sustainable buildings:

- I. Innovation
- II. Heritage
- III. Revitalization

Submission Requirements

- Nominated buildings should be practically completed before 30 June 2005.
- The Jury Panel of QBA2006 reserves the ultimate right to decide which type of award to be given to nominated buildings in accordance with their achievement in their specific area.

(C) ELIGIBILITY

- 1. Nominated buildings must be within the territorial limits of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region with no limitation in size and cost.
- 2. Nominated buildings should be practically completed. That is, eligible buildings should possess either Occupation Permits (OP or Phased OP), Acknowledgement letters on BA14 or Certificates of Completion (in the case of Government/HA projects) within the specified period as stated in the submission requirements. Subject to final approval of the Organizing Committee, possession of OP may be exempted for projects nominated for Sustainable Building Category.
- 3. A partially completed building would not be accepted unless phasing of the project is obvious enough to render the completed portion as a distinct building.
- 4. Project teams can choose to submit their nominations for **either non-residential category or residential category** subject to final approval by QBA2006 Organizing Committee.
- 5. Project teams can submit their nominations for both sustainable building category and non-residential / residential category.
- 6. A building can be nominated provided it has never received any merit/award from Quality Building Award in previous years.
- 7. Each Project Team can submit more than one nomination for different buildings. Separate nomination fee will be charged.

Notes:

- QBA2006 Organizing Committee reserves the ultimate right to make final and binding decisions on the eligibility of all applications.
- 2. QBA2006 Organizing Committee reserves the right not to bestow an award if the Jury Panel considers no nomination is worth receiving an award.
- 3. Project Teams are required to conduct a final presentation to QBA2006 Jury Panel once they are short-listed by the Organizing Committee.
- 4. The decision of the Jury Panel shall be final.
