#### (A) INTRODUCTION OF QUALITY BUILDING AWARD

The Quality Building Award is a biennial award giving public recognition to buildings of outstanding quality that demonstrate outstanding teamwork. The provision of quality buildings is an essential ingredient of a prosperous and modern society and the Quality Building Award aims to promote a collective commitment by the building industry to maintain the highest standards of professionalism and competitiveness.

The Slogan for Quality Building Award 2010 is to "Quality Transcends Time". The Quality Building Award 2010 is jointly organized by nine leading professional organizations:

The Hong Kong Construction Association

The Hong Kong Institute of Architects

The Hong Kong Institute of Construction Managers

The Hong Kong Institution of Engineers (Building, Building Services and Structural Division)

The Hong Kong Institute of Housing

The Hong Kong Institute of Surveyors

The Hong Kong Quality Assurance Agency

The Hong Kong Chapter of International Facility Management Association

The Real Estate Developers Association of Hong Kong

#### (B) AWARDS CATEGORY

Quality Building Awards will be presented as follows:

#### 1) Hong Kong Residential Category

- One Grand Winner Award
- Selected Merit Awards

#### **Submission Requirements**

- Nominated buildings should be practically completed in the period between 1 January 2007 and 30 June 2009.
- The sole purpose of the nominated buildings should be for residential use.
- The project team should demonstrate an overall excellence in quality from planning considerations to post-occupancy function to serve as a residential building.

#### 2) Hong Kong Non-Residential Category

- One Grand Winner Award
- Selected Merit Awards

#### **Submission Requirements**

- Nominated buildings should be practically completed in the period between 1 January 2007 and 30 June 2009.
- The sole purpose of the nominated buildings should be for non-residential use.
- The project team should demonstrate an overall excellence in quality from planning considerations to post-occupancy function to serve as a building for its prescribed function.

### 3) Project Outside Hong Kong Category

- One Grand Winner Award
- Selected Merit Awards

#### **Submission Requirements**

- Nominated buildings should be practically completed in the period between 1 January 2007 and 30 June 2009.
- Nominated buildings must be outside the territorial limits of Hong Kong Special Administrative Region.
- Nomination MUST be made by ONE of the 7 major team members who is a registered member of any of the nine professional organizing institutes of QBA 2010.
- The project team should demonstrate an overall excellence in quality from planning considerations to post-occupancy function to serve as a building for its prescribed function.

#### 4) Special Awards Category

To recognize projects in the field of the building industry with distinctive applications beyond the overall building function, the following three categories of special merit awards are to be considered:

- I. Historical Revitalization Developments
- II. Community Institutional Facilities
- III. Environmental and Construction Technologies
- Selected Merit Awards on each sub-category

#### **Submission Requirements**

Nominated buildings should be practically completed or occupied in the period between 1
 January 2007 and 30 June 2009.

#### (C) ELIGIBILITY

- Nominated buildings (except for Project Outside Hong Kong Category) must be within the territorial limits of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region of the People's Republic of China.
- 2. Nominated buildings should be practically completed. That is, eligible buildings should possess either Occupation Permits (OP or Phased OP), Acknowledgement letters on BA14 or Certificates of Completion (in the case of Government/HA projects) within the specified period as stated in the submission requirements. Subject to final approval of the Organizing Committee, possession of OP may be exempted for Special Awards category nominations.
- 3. A partially completed building would not be accepted unless phasing of the project is rendered as a completed portion of a distinct building with possession of OP.
- 4. Project teams can choose to submit their nominations for **any of the categories** subject to final approval by QBA2010 Organizing Committee.

- 5. Project teams may submit their nominations for both Special Awards category and Hong Kong Non-Residential / Residential category as distinctive entries to be judged independently.
- 6. A building can be nominated provided it has never received any merit/award from Quality Building Award in previous years.
- 7. The same Project Team can submit nomination for different buildings as distinctive entries. Separate nomination fee will be charged.

#### Notes:

- QBA2010 Organizing Committee reserves the ultimate right to make final and binding decisions on the eligibility of all applications.
- 2. QBA2010 Organizing Committee reserves the right not to bestow an award if the Jury Panel considers no nomination is worth receiving an award.
- 3. Project Teams are required to conduct a final presentation to QBA2010 Jury Panel once they are short-listed by the Organizing Committee.
- 4. The decision of the Jury Panel shall be final for the awards assignment.

#### (D) NOMINATION DEADLINE & SUBMISSION DETAILS

- Deadline: 12:00 noon, Friday, 15 January 2010
- Nomination documents & materials (refer to Session (G) for details) need to be delivered to Secretariat Office of QBA2010 at Room 1106-08, 11/F, C. C. Wu Building, 302-308 Hennessy Road, Wanchai, Hong Kong.
- Late submission will NOT be considered.

#### (E) NOMINATION FEE

- 1. <u>HKD5,000.00</u> will be collected for each nominated project (one nomination in one category only).
- 2. The nomination fee is non-refundable once submitted.
- 3. Submitted nomination fee of any ineligible building or project will not be refunded also.

# (F) PARTICIPATION FEE FOR QBA2010 COMMEMORATIVE STAMPS PRODUCTION FOR FINALISTS

<u>HKD\$10,000.00</u> will be collected from each finalist as a Participation Fee for production of the QBA2010 Commemorative Stamps Sheet for all Finalists in addition to the nomination fee mentioned above.

  - b) Nomination document should the followings:
    - 1. A maximum of 10,000 words to illustrate the merits under the judging criteria.
    - 2. A maximum of **20 sheets** of content materials for each nominated project.
  - c) Min. 6 electronic image files showing the entry project. [Format: in ".tif" or ".jpg" format and image size not less than 350 dpi]
